




Q2 My child asked questions about household finances and/or money management during the past ten weeks.





Q3 My child shared knowledge he's learned from school about budgeting and personal finance.











Q7 Students learn complex tasks like driving or money management best by doing, rather than just completing readings and assignments.





Q8 It is important for schools to use a long-term real-world money management simulation like Budget Challenge®.




